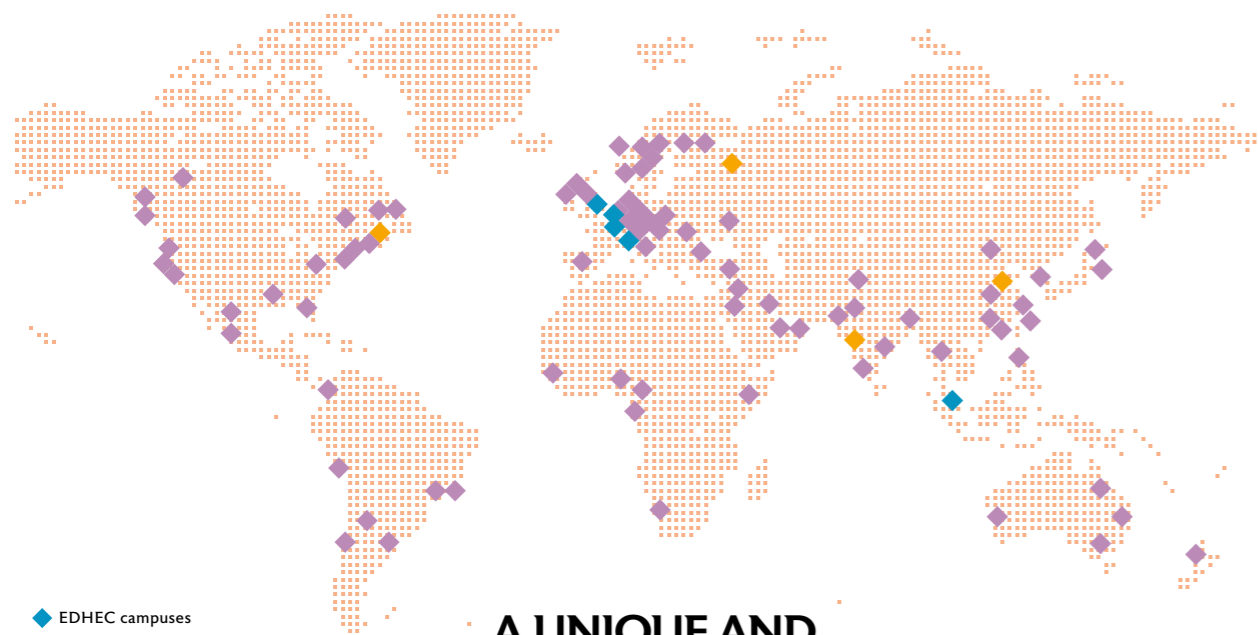

INTERNSHIP ABROAD

The Columbia University summer programme will allow you after Year 1 to study economics and finance courses and live for six weeks in New York City. Topics covered in one word are: Econometrics, Economics of Uncertainty and Information, Game Theory and Financial Economics, etc. A perfect way to learn differently.

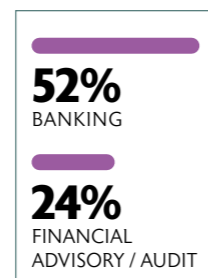

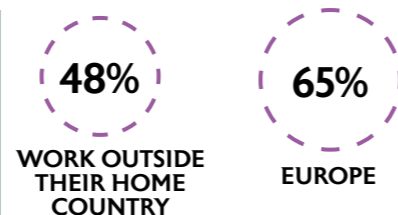

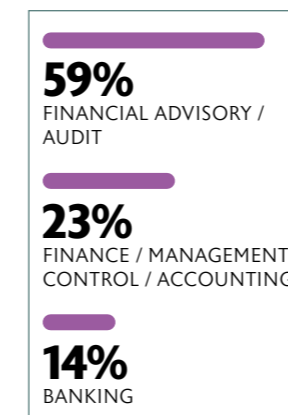

MSc in RISK & FINANCE

This programme will suit you if you have a quantitative background, are an investment industry professional or a finance professional contemplating a lateral move. The 13-month, part-time programme is taught in London. It is compatible with professional schedules and prepares you for decision-making in financial markets (pricing and hedging financial instruments, assessing and selecting investments). You will also learn the fundamentals of financial risk management and be equipped to make key corporate finance decisions.

SCHOLARSHIP & FINANCIAL AID

EDHEC offers various scholarships and financial aids based on merit and financial needs. The Excellence Scholarship, which covers 40% of tuition fees, is available to students with outstanding academic records applying before 31 March 2017. The Distinction and Foundation Scholarships, which cover 30% and 20% of tuition costs, respectively, are available to promising students applying before 30 June 2017. Other region-specific scholarships are available.

INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS OFFICE

The office assists students with all administrative procedures before their arrival and also helps new students adapt. Staff are ready to help students with questions pertaining to the French medical system, medical insurance and housing options.

VISA AND RESIDENCE PERMIT

Nationals of EU member states

EU students may live and study in France with a national ID card. No passport or visa required.

Non-nationals of EU member states

Students coming from outside the European Union must have a valid passport and obtain a student visa from the French embassy or consulate in their country of origin or permanent residence before arriving in France.

ACCOMMODATION

The International Relations Office assists students in finding suitable accommodation either on- or off-campus.
